

GO REPAIR! GRANTS

Helping to fix serious structural issues for Austin homeowners.

GO REPAIR! addresses substandard housing to make safe and barrier-free homes for Austinites. Low-income families struggling to make required home repairs may be eligible.



A GO REPAIR! GRANT IS UP TO \$20,000 PER HOME

The grant is to help fix dangerous conditions, such as leaking plumbing, faulty electric, decaying roofs, and collapsing floors.



The grant is also to make homes more accessible for homeowners with disabilities. Home modifications can ensure Austinites can get around their *home safely*.

Austin nonprofits administer the grants and repairs. Upon completion, City staff will verify the repairs. Eligible homeowners do not need to pay for any of the grant-approved repairs.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- » Applicants must live in a single-family detached house within Austin's full purpose city limits.
- » Austinites must have a gross annual income at/below 80% Median Family Income (MFI). The table below shows the income limits by number of persons living in the home.

2020 Income Limits

Number of people living in household	1 person	2 people	3 people	4 people	5 people	6 people
Annual Income at 80% MFI or less	\$54,700	\$62,500	\$70,300	\$78,100	\$84,350	\$90,600

For example: 4-person household would need to make an annual income of \$78,100 or less to qualify.
