OUR HISTORY


For over 40 years, the Austin Area Urban League has served underserved populations and persons of color, including Spanish-speaking populations in Austin, Texas and Travis County through its job training, housing programs, and education and youth development programming.

Through these efforts, the Austin Area Urban League has done extensive outreach to garner support and buy-in from the communities we serve. Beginning in the Fall of 2018, the Austin Area Urban League began working in the health space with events focused on Alzheimer's. It is the hope of the Austin Area Urban League to continue to expand its health-focused work within childhood obesity, diabetes, chronic diseases, and other ailments that disproportionately impact disenfranchised communities.

As an affiliate office of the National Urban League, who's mission is to enable African Americans and other underserved urban residents to secure economic self-reliance, parity, power and civil rights.


The Austin Area Urban League's mission is to provide tools to African Americans and under-served populations to build a foundation for social and economic equality.



Austin Area Urban League HOUSING & COMMUNITY EVELOPMENT

The Austin Area Urban League Housing and Community Development program is dedicated to revitalizing the communities of Central Texas. This program provides emergency and critical repairs to owner-occupied homes located in the City of Austin. Services under this program include crisis intervention assistance, emergency repair assistance, and major system repair.

The Housing program has served 95 households in 2021-2022 through the following programs including "cost per household" (CPH)

Go Repair: 24 Households CPH: \$24,000 2020 Output: \$576,000 Demographics: 71% Non-Hispanic or Latinx/ 29% Hispanic or Latinx

Minor Home Repair: 116 Households CPH: \$33,333 2020 Output: \$400,000 Demographics: 72% Non-Hispanic or Latinx/ 31% Hispanic or Latinx

Austin Area Urban League WORKFORCE & CAREER DEVELOPMENT The Austin Area Urban League Workforce & Career Development program empowers individuals and families to become financially self-sufficient by providing career counseling, employment assistance, professional development workshops, occupational training, financial literacy, and longterm retention strategies.

The Workforce & Career Development program has served more than 240 individuals in 2021-2022 through the following programs including "average earned salary" (AES) after program completion

Austin Area Urban League HEALTH & WELLNESS The Austin Area Urban League Health and Wellness program is committed to delivering sustainable programs that provide underserved communities with greater access to healthcare and advocate for the elimination of health disparities. Designed to aid the National Urban League empowerment goal that "Every American has to quality and affordable health care solutions by 2025."

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Austin Area Urban League launched the Central Texas Rapid Relief & Response (RRAP) program. This program provides rapid assistance and relief services that supports for individuals, families and households to offset financial hardship and provide basic needs support, to decrease the disparate impacts that have occured due to crises and or life altering events and occurrences.

RRAP Rise Program Households Served: 315 Individuals Served:1023 Average Per Household: \$1,417.37
