### Important Dates:

Oct. 24th: Early Voting Starts

Oct. 28th: Last Day to Apply for Ballot By Mail (received, not postmarked)

Nov. 4th: Last Day of Early Voting

Nov. 8th: Election Day

Nov. 9th: Last Day to Receive Ballot by Mail



### What do you need to bring with you to the polls:

- Voter I.D.
  - Acceptable Forms of ID (7)
    - Texas Driver License
    - Texas Election ID Certificate
    - Texas Personal ID Card
    - Texas Handgun License
    - US Citizenship Certificate with Photo
    - US Military ID Card
    - US Passport (Book or Card)

### If you don't have these documents:

- Fill out a Reasonable Impediment Declaration
- Show a copy of one of the following:
  - Certified Domestic Birth Certificate or Court or Admissible Birth Document (US Birth Certificate)
  - Current Utility Bill
  - Bank Statement
  - Government Check
  - Paycheck
  - Government document with your name and address including your Voter Registration Certificate
