

For over 40 years, the Austin Area Urban League has served underserved populations and persons of color, including Spanish-speaking populations in Austin, Texas and Travis County through its job training, housing programs, and education and youth development programming.

Through these efforts, the Austin Area Urban League has done extensive outreach to garner support and buy-in from the communities we serve. Beginning in the Fall of 2018, the Austin Area Urban League began working in the health space with events focused on Alzheimer's. It is the hope of the Austin Area Urban League to continue to expand its health-focused work within childhood obesity, diabetes, chronic diseases, and other ailments that disproportionately impact disenfranchised communities.

As an affiliate office of the National Urban League, we strive to enable African Americans and other underserved urban residents to secure economic self-reliance, parity, power and civil rights.

The Austin Area Urban League's mission is to provide tools to African Americans and under-served populations to build a foundation for social and economic equality.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY DAY GALA Whitney M. Young Jr. Award

The Whitney M. Young, Jr. Award is given by boards of directors of Urban League affiliates across the country in memory of the great civil rights leader and former head of the National Urban League. Young was one of America's most charismatic, courageous and influential civil rights pioneers. He worked tirelessly to gain access for African Americans to good jobs, education, housing, health care and social services.

During Young's ten-year tenure at the League, he brought the organization to the forefront of the Civil Rights Movement. Young expressed the mission of the Urban League not as ground-level activism in itself but as the supplement and complement of the activities of all other organizations; he states, "We are the social engineers, we are the strategists, we are the planners, we are the people who work at the level of policymaking, policy implementation, the highest echelons of the corporate community, the highest echelons of the governmental community – both at the federal, state and local level - the highest echelons of the labor movement."

As part of the League's new mission, Young initiated programs like "Street Academy," an alternative education system to prepare high school dropouts for college, and "New Thrust," an effort to help local black leaders identify and solve community problems.










Austin Area Urban League HOUSING & COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

The Austin Area Urban League Housing and Community Development program is dedicated to revitalizing the communities of Central Texas. This program provides emergency and critical repairs to owner-occupied homes located in the City of Austin. Services under this program include crisis intervention assistance, emergency repair assistance, and major system repair.

The Housing program has served 107 households in 2022-2023 through the following programs including "cost per household"(CPH).

Minor Home Repair: 107 Households CPH: \$8,500

Demographics: 61% Non-Hispanic or Latinx/ 33% Hispanic or Latinx 13% White

Austin Area Urban League WORKFORCE&CAREER ELOPMENT

The Austin Area Urban League Workforce & Career Development program empowers individuals and families to become financially self-sufficient by providing career counseling, employment assistance, professional development workshops, occupational training, financial literacy, and long-term retention strategies.

The Workforce & Career Development program has served more than 240 individuals in 2021-2022 through the following programs including "average earned salary" (AES) after program completion.

The Education and Youth Development program works earnestly to develop innovative programs to support academic achievement, civic involvement, and the physical and emotional development of children and youth. Programming includes early childhood education, post-secondary success, and youth leadership designed to help achieve the NUL empowerment goal of assuring that every child will be ready for college, work, and life by 2025.

The Education & Youth Development program is currently serving 263 students through the following programs including "average cost per student" per program.

The Austin Area Urban League Health and Wellness program is committed to delivering sustainable programs that provide underserved communities with greater access to healthcare and advocate for the elimination of health disparities. Designed to aid the National Urban League empowerment goal that "Every American has quality and affordable health care solutions by 2025."

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Austin Area Urban League launched the Central Texas Rapid Relief & Response (RRAP) program. This program provides rapid assistance and relief services that support individuals, families and households to offset financial hardship and provide basic needs and support, to decrease the disparate impacts that have occurred due to crises or life altering events and occurrences.
